(Northern Sicily)

Visit *Capo Market* for street food, explore *Cattedrale di Palermo* and *Palazzo dei Normanni* and dine at *Trattoria Altri Tempi* for Sicilian cuisine.

(Northern Sicily)

Explore *Ballarò market* in the morning, then visit *ZACentrale* for contemporary art and relax in *Piazza Marina*. Finish the day with a performance at *Teatro Massimo* and dinner at Michelin-starred *Gagin*.

(Northern Sicily)

Visit *Vulcano* for a day of hiking in Volanello's volcanic landscapes, relax with a mud bath and thermal dip and enjoy dinner at Therasia Resort's Michelin-starred restaurants, *Il Cappero* or *I Tenerumi*.

(Eastern Sicily)

Visit Noto to appreciate its Baroque architecture and key landmarks like the local cathedral and *Palazzo Castelluccio*, explore modern art at *Sergio Fiorentino's studio*, and relax with a cocktail and pastries at *Morgana* and *Caffè Sicilia*.
